MAKE YOUR MARK SCHOLARSHIP

SkillsUSA has partnered with *Aerotek* to provide the “Make Your Mark” scholarship. The “Make Your Mark” scholarship program supports the SkillsUSA Career Model and expands the talent pipeline to remove barriers of entry to education and training. Aerotek’s intention is to develop the pipeline of future skilled trades leaders and improve economic outcomes for SkillsUSA members.

Based on the estimated costs of the educational program and experience documented on the application, students will be eligible for the following award for **FALL 2025 ONLY**.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

1. *Applicants must* be a high school senior or a current or enrolling college/postsecondary student who is expecting a tuition bill or who has documented direct educational costs for the Fall 2025 academic term (tools, PPE, on-campus or housing bill).
2. *Applicants must* be registered and paid members of SkillsUSA for the 2024–25 school year.
3. *Applicants must* be planning to enroll in one of the following programs for Fall 2025:
 - Community college
 - Certificate program
 - Technical college
 - An apprenticeship program
4. *Applicants must* be continuing their education/training in one of these pathways:
 - Construction
 - Manufacturing
 - Transportation, Distribution and Logistics
 - Telecommunications Cabling Training
 - Electronics Technology or Industrial Engineering Technology
5. *Applicants must* NOT be former “Make Your Mark” scholarship recipients.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND DISTRIBUTION

If selected, recipients must submit a Scholarship Acceptance Form by the deadline that includes:

- Agreement to all scholarship terms and conditions.
- Official documentation to support the recipient’s scholarship application (a tuition bill, an on-campus housing bill, receipts or a detailed list on school or apprenticeship letterhead of the required tools/PPE/expenses and the total cost).
- A written note of thanks or a video-recorded message to thank the scholarship sponsor, Aerotek.
